BY-LAW

Number 282-89

To amend By-law 193-83 (the regulation of traffic)
for the removal of an ALL WAY STOP
at Post Road and Vodden Street East

The council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby
ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 193-83, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule VIII
thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>BETWEEN</u>
Vodden Street East	The east limit of Main Street North and the west limit of Post Road
Vodden Street East	The east limit of Post Street and the east limit of the road

(2) by adding to the specified columns of Schedule VIII
thereto the following items:

THROUGH HIGHWAYS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>HIGHWAY</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>BETWEEN</u>
Vodden Street East	The east limit of Main Street North and the east limit of the road


(3) by deleting from the specified columns of Schedule IX thereto the following items:

STOP SIGNS

<u>COLUMN 1</u> <u>INTERSECTION</u>	<u>COLUMN 2</u> <u>FACING TRAFFIC</u>
Post Road and Vodden Street East	Westbound on Vodden Street East
Post Road and Vodden Street East	Eastbound on Vodden Street East
Post Road and Vodden Street East	Northbound on Post Road

This by-law shall not come into force until approved by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 13th day of November, 1989.
