BY-LAW

Number 283-88

To amend By-law 200-82, as amended, (Part of Lot 7, Concession 1, E.H.S.)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 200-82, as amended, is hereby further amended by:
 - (1) by deleting section 202.1(j) thereof and substituting therefor the following:

"202.1(j) one community club".
 - (2) by adding to section 202.1 thereof the following:

"202.1(k) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes".
 - (3) by adding to section 202.2 thereof the following:

"202.2(p) the gross floor area of a community club shall not exceed 100 square metres.

(q) the community club use shall no longer be permitted after December 19, 1991."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL,
this 19th day of December 1988.

DECLARATION


I, LEONARD J. MIKULICH, of the City of Brampton, in
