



AMENDED BY BY-LAW 282-2002

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 285-85

To provide for the payment of a retirement allowance to members of council.

WHEREAS section 238 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended) authorizes the council of a municipality to pay remuneration to the members in any manner that council considers advisable;

NOW THEREFORE, the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. When a member of the 1985 or any subsequent council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton (herein called the "Council") ceases to be a member of the Council, such former member shall be entitled to payment of a retirement allowance pursuant to the provisions of this by-law.
2. (1) The retirement allowance shall be calculated by the Chief Administrative Officer and Treasurer (herein called the "Treasurer"), and payment of it shall be made at the same time as any other final payments by the City to such member.
(2) The retirement allowance for a member of the Council shall be calculated at the rate of one week's current salary for every year of service on the Council, for the period from 1 January 1974 to the date upon which the member ceased to be a member of the Council.
(3) The Treasurer, in calculating the amount of the allowance pursuant to section 2(2), shall treat any 12 months of service as a year of service, and any remainder of 6 months or more as an additional year of service, with the calculation of the years of service to remain unaffected if the remainder is 5 months or less.
3. Any retirement allowance paid pursuant to this by-law shall not be subject to any deduction because of membership in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System.
4. Any member of the Council may, prior to receiving payment of a retirement allowance pursuant to this by-law, give written direction to and make arrangements with the Treasurer for payment of the retirement allowance to such institution, agency or person as may be set out in such written direction, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized to comply therewith.
