# BY-LAW

**Number** 286-81  
To prevent the application of  
Part Lot Control of certain  
Plans of Subdivision in the City  
of Brampton (Plan M-104)  
(FIRST CITY DEVELOPMENTS)


WHEREAS subsection 29 (5) of The Planning Act (R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 379, as amended) has imposed part lot control on all registered plans within the City;


AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 29 (10) of The Planning Act, the Council of the Municipality may by by-law provide that such part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of Section 29 of The Planning Act does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A attached hereto.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 23rd day of November, 1981.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW \_\_\_\_\_
