BY-LAW

to change the name of part of Tomken Road

WHEREAS paragraph 105 of section 210 of the <u>Municipal</u> <u>Act</u> (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, as amended) permits the council of a local municipality to pass by-laws changing the names of public highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Brampton deems it expedient to change the names of certain public highways;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four successive weeks in The Daily Times, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council has heard all persons who claimed that they would be adversely affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The name of the street known as "Tomken Road" (formerly known as Heart Lake Road), being the road allowance between Concessions 2 and 3, East of Hurontario Street, from the southerly boundary of the City of Brampton as established by subsection 2(4) of the <u>Regional Municipality of Peel Act</u> (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 440, as amended) to the easterly limit of Highway Number 410, save and except the lands shown as Part 7 on a reference plan deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as number 43R-11162, is changed to and is to be known as part of "Farmhouse Court".

The street name change effected by section 1 to this by-law 2. is shown on the map attached as Schedule A hereto. READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED IN OPEN , 1984. December COUNCIL THIS 10th DAY OF






