A By-law to amend By-law 117-76  
as amended (CANADIAN TIRE  
CORPORATION LIMITED)


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 117-76, as amended, being a By-law to regulate the use and erection of signs within the City and;  
WHEREAS in accordance with By-law 117-76, as amended, the Canadian Tire Corporation Limited could erect in compliance with Section 6, Subsection vii, a 9,600 square foot sign and;  
WHEREAS the Canadian Tire Corporation have requested Council to provide an exception to the By-law to enable the relocation of two existing wall fascia signs and the installation of one new wall fascia sign contrary to the By-law recognizing the size of the building and the property and;  
WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deem it advisable to provide for an exception to By-law 117-76, as amended;  
NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. By-law 117-76 be amended by the addition of the following new section and by the addition of Schedule 'A' annexed hereto:

14. Exceptions

None of the provisions of this By-law are intended to prohibit the erection of a sign or signs in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 'A' attached hereto.
