The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 31-81, as amended by By-laws 260-83 and 203-84, is hereby further amended by deleting section 9 thereof, and substituting therefor the following:
  - "9. (1) Except as permitted by sections 9(2), 9(3), 12 and 13, no person shall keep, or permit to be kept, more than two pigeons, more than two rabbits, more than two domestic fowl or more than two game fowl on the premises of or in a dwelling unit located on land the use of which is restricted to residential purposes and which is within a registered plan of subdivision or a built-up urban area.
    - (2) A person may keep up to 25 pigeons, 25 rabbits, 25 domestic fowl or 25 game fowl on land used for residential purposes and within Registered Plans 999 and M-79.
    - (3) The offspring of the animals permitted to be kept by subsections 9(1) and 9(2) may be kept on the same premises for up to 3 months after their births.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL this 10th day of December, 1984.
