To stop up and close and authorize
the sale of part of Rollingwood Drive
on Plan 43M-1160; Part 13 on
Reference Plan 43R-29445

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the Part of Rollingwood Drive on Plan 43M-1160 designated as Part 13 on Plan 43R-29445 described in Schedule A to this by-law be stopped up and closed and sold to the owner of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once in the Brampton Guardian, a newspaper published in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* have been carried out;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The part of Rollingwood Drive described in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby stopped up and closed and declared surplus.
2. The sale to 728184 Ontario Limited of the part of Rollingwood Drive described in Schedule A hereto for a price of \$2.00 is hereby authorized.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments approved by the City Solicitor as may be necessary to effect the conveyance of the Lands.
4. The affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich attached as Schedule B to this by-law forms part of this by-law.




Affidavit of Leonard J. Mikulich
