To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M -1812

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements for single detached lots, and, for the purpose of

imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the <i>Planning Act</i> does not apply to the following lands:
City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:
The whole of Lots 7, 8, 11,12, 15, 26, 32, 34, 37 to 39 inclusive, 41, 45 to 57 inclusive, 60 to 63 inclusive, 66 to 68 inclusive, 70 to 73 inclusive, 75 to 86 inclusive, 90 to 94 inclusive, 98 to 105 inclusive, 107 to 109 inclusive, 111 to 113 inclusive, 115, 119, 120, 122, 123, 126 to 129 inclusive, 132 to 138 inclusive, 140 to 145 inclusive, 203, 210 to 212 inclusive, 215 to 221 inclusive, 223, 226, 227 230, 231, 234, 235, 237, 238, 268, 270, 271 and Blocks 279, 294 to 297 inclusive, and, Blocks 301 to 311 inclusive on Registered Plan 43M-1812.
