



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 304-83

To establish a community recreation centre known as Earnscliffe Recreation Centre

WHEREAS section 2(1) of the Community Recreation Centres Act provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a community recreation centre in accordance with the said Act;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton owns and operates the EARNSCLIFFE RECREATION CENTRE at 44 Eastbourne Drive in Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the said EARNSCLIFFE RECREATION CENTRE was not previously established in accordance with the said Act;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. A community recreation centre, consisting of the lands and premises municipally known as 44 Eastbourne Drive in Brampton, and the buildings and facilities thereon, including the community hall, arena, pool, fitness area, squash courts and meeting and crafts rooms, is hereby established in accordance with the provisions of the Community Recreation Centres Act (R.S.O. 1980, c.80,) as amended), to be operated and maintained by The Corporation of the City of Brampton, and shall be known as the "EARNSCLIFFE RECREATION CENTRE".

2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in open Council this 21st day of November, 1983.
