BY-LAW

Number 304 - 2012

To amend By-law 399-2002, as amended,
The Sign By-law

WHEREAS; the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton approved programs to identify necessary wayfinding and accomplishment signs;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows.

THAT By-law 399-2002, as amended, is hereby further amended

- 1) By adding thereto Section 4 DEFINITIONS, Sentence (62) to read:
4.(62) "Accomplishment Sign" shall mean a sign erected by the City of Brampton to identify a special recognition, achievement, designation bestowed upon the City of Brampton, or an affiliated community club, charity, non-profit corporation/association, of City-wide significance that meets a provincial or national or international standard of excellence, accreditation or distinction. The accomplishment should promote and enhance the image of Brampton. The accomplishment must be recognized by City Council in the form of a resolution or bylaw.

- 2) by adding the following section:

CITY SIGNS ERECTED ON A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY:

11. Notwithstanding Section 5.(5) REGULATIONS AND PROHIBITIONS, the City may erect or cause to be erected signage for the purpose of civic messaging, wayfinding and/or accomplishment signs on the road right-of-way.

- 3) by correcting the numbering sequence following Section 11, CITY SIGNS ERECTED ON A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 24TH day of October, 2012.
