To amend By-Law 51-2000, as amended, an Interim Control By-Law applicable to areas subject to By-law 56-83 (former Township of Toronto Gore Comprehensive Zoning By-law), By-law 139-84 (former Town of Mississauga Comprehensive Zoning By-law), By-law 151-88 (former Township of Chinguacousy Comprehensive Zoning By-law), and By-law 200-82 (former Town of Brampton Comprehensive Zoning By-law).

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


1. By-Law 51-2000, as amended, is hereby further amended by:
 - (1) Adding as Schedule "K", the Schedule "A" attached to this By-law.
 - (2) By adding as Section 7, the following:
 7. Notwithstanding Section 1, a Group Home Type 1, may be permitted on the lands outlined on Schedule "K" to this by-law.

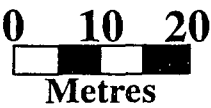
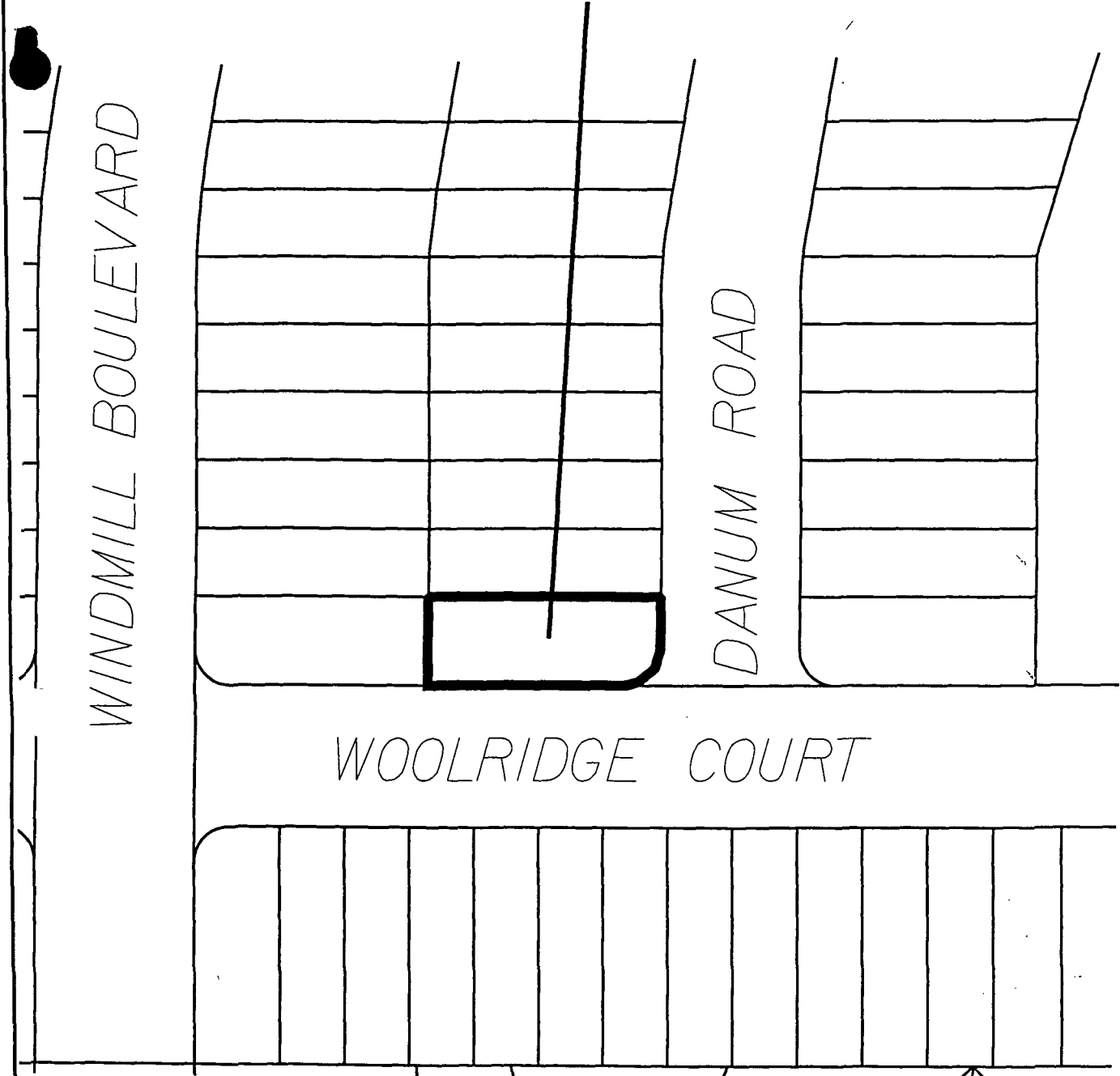

FROM INTERIM CONTROL BY-LAW 51-2000



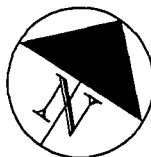



