# BY-LAW

Number 317-2005

To authorize the purchase of certain lands from Orion Properties Ltd., and Orlando Corporation to expand the Sandalwood Works Yard and to repeal By-Law 269-2005

Section 6 of the *Municipal Act 2001* authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described to expand a City Works Yard.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-Law 269-2005 to authorize the acquisition of the said lands, but the By-Law contained a typographical error in the legal description of the said lands.

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The purchase of the lands described as Part of Lot 14, Concession 1, in the City of Brampton, and designated as Parts 3, 4, 5 and 6 and the release of any easement rights over Part 11 all on Plan 43R- 19716 for the purposes of expanding a City Works Yard, is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between vendor, Orion Properties Ltd., Orlando Corporation and purchaser, The Corporation of the City of Brampton, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said land.
3. The funds for the acquisition shall be taken from capital project account #034860.
4. By-Law 269-2005 is hereby repealed.
