THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 318-2005

To authorize the expropriation of certain lands for the expansion of the Sandalwood Works Yard and to repeal By-Law 270-2005

Section 6 of the *Municipal Act 2001* authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to expropriate the lands herein described to expand a City Work Yard.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-Law 270-2005 to authorize the expropriation of the said land but the By-Law contained a typographical error in the legal description of the lands

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The expropriation of the lands in the City of Brampton, described as Part of Lot 14, Concession 1, W.H.S., in the City of Brampton and designated as Parts 3, 4, 5 and 6 and the release of any easements rights over Part 11, all on Plan 43R-19716, for the purposes of expanding a City Work Yard is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as expropriating authority, all notices, applications, advertisements and other documents required by the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.26, as amended, in order to effect the expropriations of the said lands.
3. By-Law 270-2005 is hereby repealed.
