Brampton Safety Council


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacted By-law 4-83, which established and created terms of reference and the composition of the City of Brampton Safety Council;


AND WHEREAS pursuant to Recommendation SC120-2002, approved by Council on October 28, 2002, it is deemed expedient to increase the membership of the Brampton Safety Council to include representation from Brampton Fire and Emergency Services;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 4-83, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
  - (1) By deleting Section 1. d) and substituting therefor the following:
    - "d) One representative from each of the following:
      - staff representative from Peel Regional Police Regional Traffic Unit
      - staff representative from City of Brampton Works and Transportation Department
      - staff representative from Student Transportation Office, Peel District School Board/Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board
      - staff representative from Brampton Fire and Emergency Services
      - Chair of the Road Watch Steering Committee – Brampton Safe City Association."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 28<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2002.
