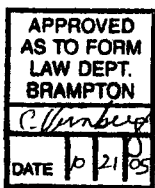
To amend the Zoning By-law 2004 (By-law 270-2004) as amended

WHEREAS the City of Brampton wishes to enact a housekeeping amendment to correct a mapping error on Schedule A that moved a zoning boundary, which occurred during the consolidation of Zoning By-Law 270-2004.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The Zoning By-law 2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by changing on Schedule A thereto, the land use designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A attached to this by-law from "HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL TWO (HC2)" to "COMMERCIAL TWO - SECTION 3162 (C2-SECTION 3162)".

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in open COUNCIL, this **24th** day of **OCTOBER** 2005.



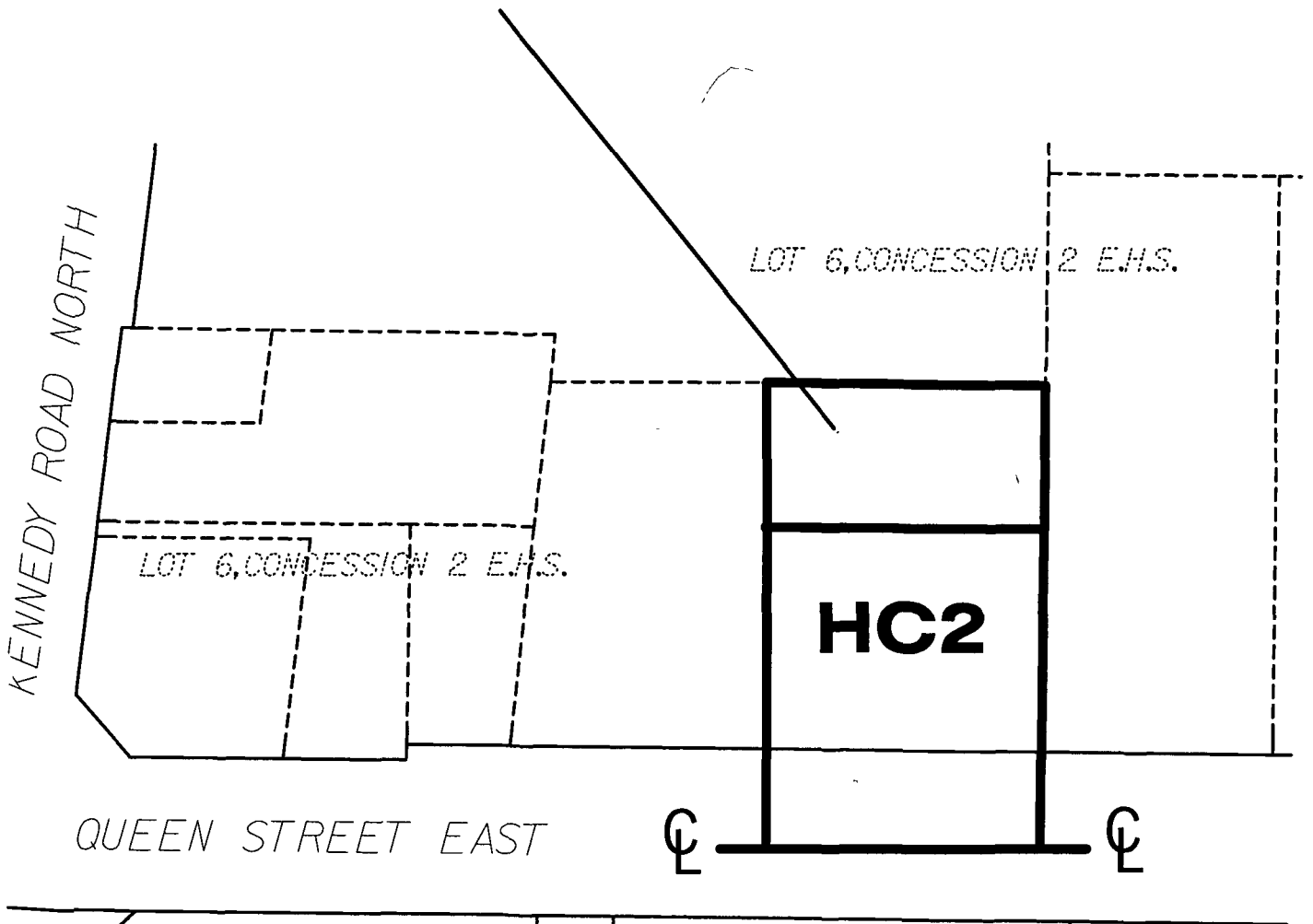

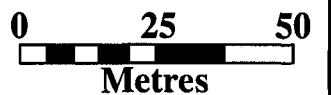

C2-SECTION 3162

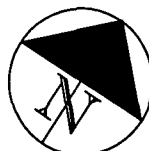


LEGEND

PART LOT 6, CONCESSION 2 E.H.S.



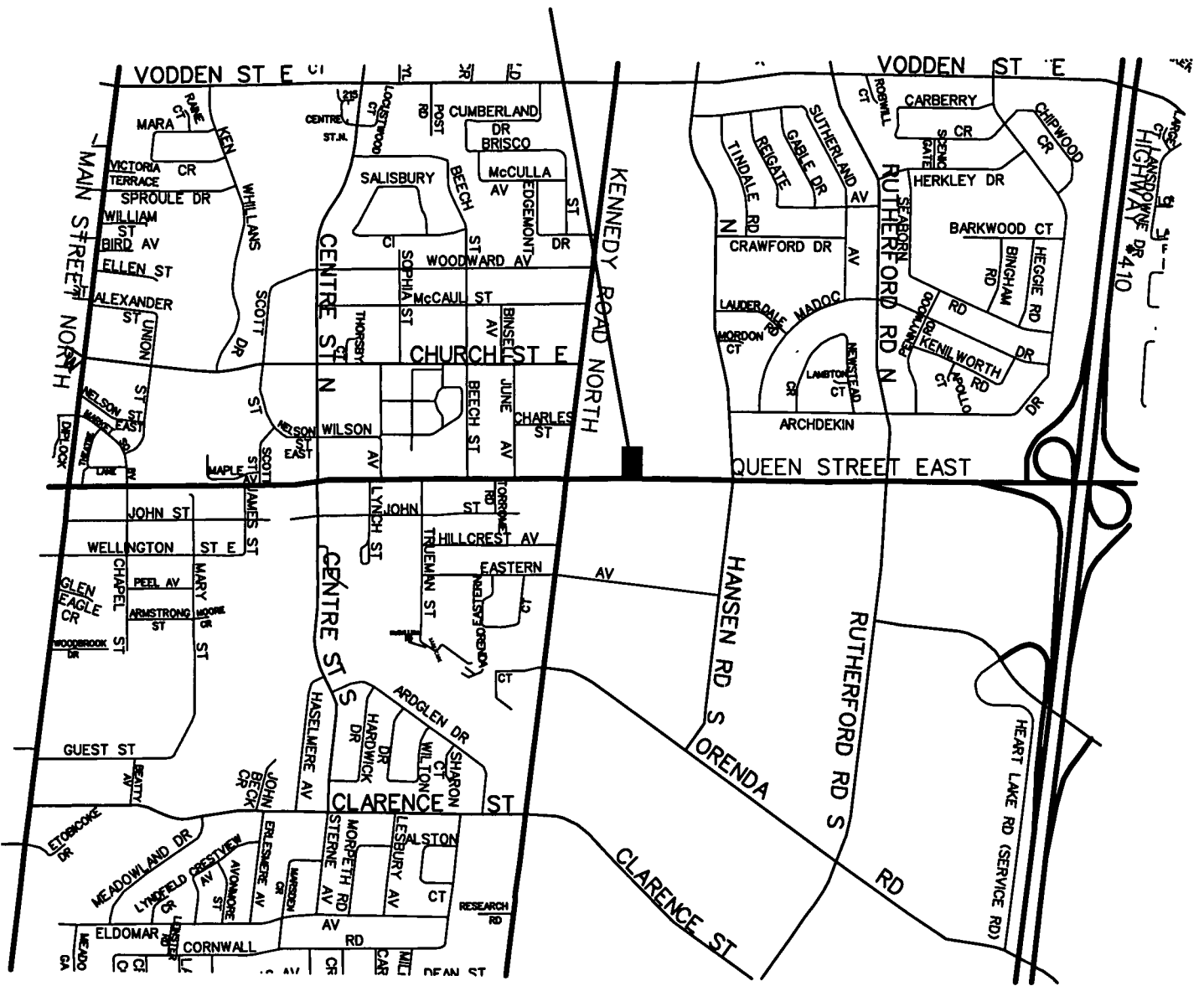

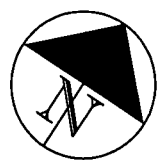


DECLARATION
