Number 335-2012

To Declare Surplus certain lease and permanent easement interests Over City-owned Valley Lands adjacent to the West Branch of the Humber River


WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that certain lease and permanent easement interests over that portion of the valley lands adjacent to the West Branch of the Humber River, north and south of Cottrelle Blvd. and east of McVean Drive, having an area of approximately 72 acres, as illustrated on attached Schedule A, be declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT limited interest rights, being lease and permanent easement rights, over about 72 acres of City-owned lands adjacent to the West Branch of the Humber River, approximated by bold outline on Schedule A to this by-law, be declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton.

READ a **FIRST, SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 28th day of November, 2012.
