To Amend By-Law 200-82

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-Law 200-82, as amended by By-Law 239-2000 is hereby further amended as follows:

(1). Section 20.6.5 is deleted and replaced with the following:

"20.6.5 The lands within the "Central Area Boundary" as shown outlined on Schedule "B-2" to this by-law shall be exempt from the parking requirements of Section 20.6 for commercial use only, and for a temporary period expiring December 31, 2003."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 25th day of November, 2002.




