A by-law to provide for information to voters
to be translated into other languages for
City of Brampton Municipal Elections


WHEREAS Section 9(2) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law allowing the use of French and other languages other than English on information provided to voters;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That "how to vote" information for elections conducted under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* be translated into those languages spoken at home by at least 0.5% of the population according to the most recent Census, plus French; and
2. That the translated "how to vote" information be posted on the CityVote web page and made available to voters at all Voting Locations on Election Day and all Advance Voting days.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 11th day of October, 2006.
