To amend By-law 270-2004, as amended

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:

(1) by changing Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands as shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law:

AGRICULTURAL (A)	COMMERCIAL TWO – 2355 (C2- 2355)

(2) by adding thereto the following section:

"2355 The lands designated C2-2355 on Schedule A to this by-law:

2355.1

a)

shall only be used for the purposes permitted in a C2

- zone and the following additional uses:
 - a day nursery (i)
 - a private school (ii)
- a seasonal garden centre (iii)
- b) shall not be used for the following purposes:
 - an adult entertainment parlour (i)
 - (ii) an adult video store
 - an adult book store (iii)
 - a massage or body rub parlour (iv)
 - (v) an amusement arcade

- shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - Minimum Front Yard Depth: 3.0 metres a)
 - Minimum Interior Side Yard Width: 9.0 metres b)

C)	Minimum	Exterior	Side	Yard	Width:	3.0	metres
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- d) Minimum Rear Yard Depth: 10.0 metres
- e) Minimum Landscaped Open Space:

 i) 3.0 metres wide along the northerly, easterly and southerly lot lines, except at approved vehicular access locations; and,

- ii) 2.3 metres wide along the westerly lot line.
- f) Maximum Gross Commercial Floor Area:

6,000 square metres

g) Minimum setback of an above ground utility structure:

3.0 metres from all lot lines.

- h) Minimum Parking Spaces: 1 space per 23.5 square metres of gross commercial floor area or portion thereof.
- i) A drive through facility is only permitted for a bank, trust company or finance company.
- j) Minimum number of stacking spaces for a drive through facility: 3
- k) Maximum number of drive through facilities: 2
- All restaurants shall contain a climate controlled garbage room within a building or structure and all other uses shall provide a garbage room within a building or structure.
- m) Outside storage shall not be permitted."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 14th day of December, 2012.
