


To amend By-law 56-83 as amended.

By-law 56-83, as amended, is hereby further amended by changing on Sheet 1 of Schedule A thereto, the zoning designation of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A to this by-law from AGRICULTURAL (A) to RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY A – SECTION 774 (R1A - SECTION 774), INSTITUTIONAL – SECTION 778 (I1 - SECTION 778), and OPEN SPACE (OS).


READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL, this 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 2003.

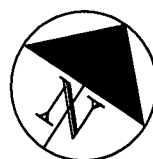


I, LEONARD JOSEPH MIKULICH, of the Town of Shelburne, in the County of Dufferin, DO SOLEMNLY
