To amend Interim Control By-Law 306-2003, An Interim Control By-Law applicable to Part of the Area Subject to By-Law 270-2004, as amended.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-Law 306-2003 as amended by By-Law 305-2004, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - 1.1 Section 1 is amended by adding after the words "Except as provided for in Section 1.1 and Section 1.2", the following:

"and Section 1.3"

- 1.2 The following is added as Section 1.3:
 - "1.3 The lands described as Part of Lot 10, Concession 5 W.H.S. which comprise an area of 38 acres (15.3 hectares) and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption From Interim Control By-Law 306-2003, as amended by By-Law as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall only permit a golf driving range."
- 1.3 Schedule A is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this By-Law.


