To prevent the application of part lot control to part of

lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the *Planning* Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the *Planning Act* does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

The whole of lots 3, 4, 5, 7 to 26, 28 to 33, 36, 37, 40, 42 to 47, 49, 50, 63 to 70, 73, 76 to 84, 87 to 92, 112 to 117, 119 to 126, 132 to 135, 137 to 144, 146 to 150, 153, 157, 159, 160, 170, 173, 175, 176, 178 to 182, 185, on Registered Plan 43M-1674

2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the *Planning Act*, this by-law shall expire on November 14, 2006.
