- By-law 270-2004, as amended, is hereby further amended:
  - Section 20.3.3 is deleted and replaced with the following: (1)

The lands shown outlined and identified as "Parking Exemption Area" on Schedule B-5 to this by-law shall be exempt from the parking requirements set out in Section 20.3.2 for a commercial use only, and for a temporary period expiring on December 31, 2011."

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL,


