

## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

## **BY-LAW**

Number 380 - 2004

To authorize surplus lands and transfer of lands

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton that the City transfer the lands described as Part of Lot 14, Concession 3 E.H.S. designated as Parts 4, 5, 7, 9, 16, 21, 22, 23 and 24, 43R-28978 (the "Lands") in exchange for a receiving lands Part of Lot 14, Concession 3 E.H.S. designated as Parts 10, 15 and 26 on Plan 43R-28978 ("Replacement Lands");

**AND WHEREAS** the procedures required by section 268 of the *Municipal Act,* 2001 have been carried out;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council The Corporation of the City of Brampton has heard in person or by counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The Lands are hereby declared to be surplus.
- 2. The transfer of the Lands in exchange for the Replacement Lands is hereby authorized and the City Solicitor is hereby authorized to execute all documents and instruments as may be necessary to effect the transfer of the said lands.

**READ** a **FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this  $13^{\rm th}$  day of December, 2004.
