## KEY PROJECTS 2021 TO 2026: RECORD INVESTMENTS - DELIVERING ON RECREATION



### SANDALWOOD PARK OUTDOOR RINKS Premier outdoor skating and community gathering space

A transformative park revitalization introducing two full-size NHL outdoor rinks, designed to support both organized programming and casual public skating. The project creates a vibrant, multi-season destination for recreation, gathering, and community connection. A new fieldhouse with change rooms and more coming soon!

### NEW EMBLETON COMMUNITY CENTRE A transformative, city-building recreation destination

One of Brampton's most ambitious civic projects, the New Embleton Community Centre will be a 175,000 sq. ft., multi-use facility designed to serve a rapidly growing community. The centre will feature aquatics (including a leisure and lap pool), fitness and wellness spaces, licensed childcare, flexible multi-purpose rooms, and community gathering areas, complemented by outdoor amenities such as sports fields and landscaped public spaces. A landmark \$64M federal investment, announced in April 2026, supports this \$150-\$200M project—highlighting strong intergovernmental partnership and a shared commitment to complete communities. Designed to achieve LEED Silver certification and Net Zero Ready standards, the facility will prioritize energy efficiency, accessibility, and long-term sustainability. Once complete, the Embleton Community Centre will serve as a vibrant hub for recreation, wellness, and connection for generations to come.

**BALMORAL RECREATION CENTRE EXPANSION**  
**A modern hub for wellness, recreation, and community life**

Reopened in June 2025, this landmark redevelopment has transformed Balmoral into a modern, 35,000 sq. ft. community hub—nearly double its original size. The facility features Brampton’s deepest pool at 12 feet, a sauna, a FIBA-sized gymnasium, and flexible multipurpose spaces designed for diverse programming. Outdoor additions, including a new splash pad and playground, complement enhanced accessibility and energy-efficient design, creating an inclusive space for residents of all ages and abilities.

**Investment: \$25M**

**Opened: June 2025**



**MONKTON CIRCLE PARK**  
**Neighbourhood green space for everyday connection**

A six-acre neighbourhood park providing accessible green space for families, seniors, and youth. Designed to support everyday recreation and relaxation, it enhances community connectivity and access to nature.

**Investment: \$3.9M**

**Opened: December 2025**



**FIELD OF DREAMS ACCESSIBLE**  
**BASEBALL FACILITY**

**Inclusive sport for players of all abilities**

A fully accessible baseball complex featuring barrier-free design, spectator seating, and integrated amenities. The facility expands inclusive sport opportunities while serving local schools and the broader community.

**Investment: \$225K**

**Opened: November 2021**



**TURNER FENTON CRICKET FIELD**  
**Expanding access through partnership and shared space**

Developed in partnership with the Peel District School Board, this fully lit cricket pitch features artificial turf wickets and player pavilions. The joint-use model expands access for both students and community groups, supporting one of Brampton’s fastest-growing sports.

**Investment: \$1.45M**

**Opened: April 2025**



**MEMORIAL ARENA EXPANSION**  
**Upgraded facilities for players and community use**

A 3,000 sq. ft. addition delivering new change rooms, showers, office space, and storage. These upgrades improve functionality and enhance the experience for athletes and community users.

**Investment: \$3.2M**

**Opened: December 2025**



**ROSALEA TENNIS DOME**

**Keeping youth active all year round**

This project introduced three new high-quality tennis courts paired with a seasonal dome, ensuring year-round access for youth and community players. It responds to growing demands and supports consistent participation regardless of weather conditions.

**Investment: \$6.8M**

**Opened: December 2024**



**CENTRAL PEEL TURF FIELD**

**A premier multi-sport destination for community and schools**

A collaborative multi-sport facility featuring a synthetic turf field, 8-lane running track, basketball courts, and cricket practice area. With modern lighting and spectator amenities, it serves both students and the broader community.

**Investment: \$1.7M**

**Opened: July 2023**



**ATIBA HUTCHINSON BOXED SOCCER COURT**  
**Fast, creative play in a uniquely designed space**

One of only two of its kind in Canada, this fully lit outdoor court encourages fast-paced, creative play in a compact space. Designed for unprogrammed use, it provides an accessible and inclusive environment for skill development and community play.

**Investment: \$500K**

**Opened: May 2024**



**SUSAN FENNEL SPORTSPLEX**  
**NET-ZERO RETROFIT**

**Leading the way in sustainable recreation infrastructure**

As Brampton’s first net-zero carbon recreation facility, this project represents a major step toward the City’s climate goals. The retrofit includes energy-efficient upgrades and sustainable design features that reduce environmental impact while modernizing a key community facility.

**Investment: \$36.4M**

**Completed: September 2025**

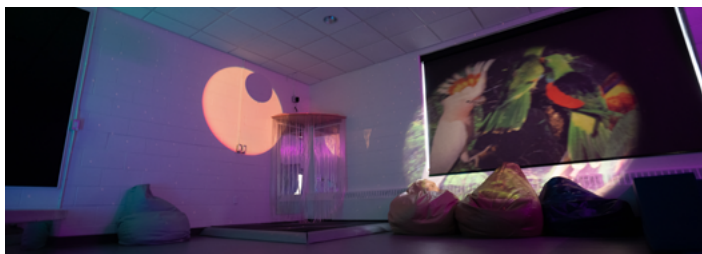


**CHINGUACOUSY PARK TENNIS CLUB RENOVATION**  
**Upgrading a key community tennis destination**

Renovations and a building addition enhanced the tennis facility, improving programming capacity and the overall user experience.

**Investment: \$2.3M**

**Completed: 2024**



**PAUL PALLESCHI RECREATION CENTRE REVITALIZATION**  
**Renewed spaces for fitness, wellness, and community**

Extensive renovations modernized this facility with a refreshed pool, upgraded fitness areas, new multipurpose rooms, and improved accessibility. Energy-efficient upgrades enhance sustainability and user comfort.

**Investment: \$6.3M**

**Opened: 2021**



**SUSAN FENNELL YOUTH HUB**  
**A space for creativity, connection, and opportunity**

This modern, open-concept space was transformed into a collaborative hub featuring e-sports, creative studios, meeting rooms, and lounge areas. It also provides access to leadership programs, employment supports, and social services, creating an ultimate resource center for youth engagement.

**Investment: \$1.7M**

**Opened: May 2023**



**SAVE MAX SPORTS CENTRE DOME & FIELDHOUSE**  
**Extending play beyond the season**

A seasonal dome and upgraded turf fields allow for year-round use and expanded programming. Improvements reduce weather disruptions and support a wide range of sports, complemented by a new pavilion with washroom and change room facilities.

**Investment: \$11.3M**

**Opened: July 2021**

**OUTDOOR RINKS (BOREHAM & PEEL VILLAGE PARKS)**  
**Bringing winter activity closer to home**

New outdoor skating rinks expanded access to winter recreation, supporting active living and providing more opportunities for residents to enjoy seasonal activities close to home.

**Investment: \$1M**

**Opened: December 2023**



**RIVERSTONE COMMUNITY CENTRE REVITALIZATION**  
**Modern, inclusive spaces for health and recreation**

Riverstone Community Centre is a renovated 34,000-square-foot recreation facility featuring an updated pool area, including a saltwater pool, expanded change rooms and fitness rooms and several multi-purpose rooms.

**Investment: \$12.5M**

**Opened: July 2022**

**YOUTH CRICKET FIELDS (MULTIPLE PARKS)**  
**Growing the game from the ground up**

New cricket fields at Allan Kerbel, County Court, and Blue Oak Parks expand access for young players and introduce more residents to the sport. These investments support grassroots development and active lifestyles.

**Investment: \$3M**

**Opened: June 2024**



**OUTDOOR REFRIGERATED RINKS**  
**Winter recreation made accessible across the city**

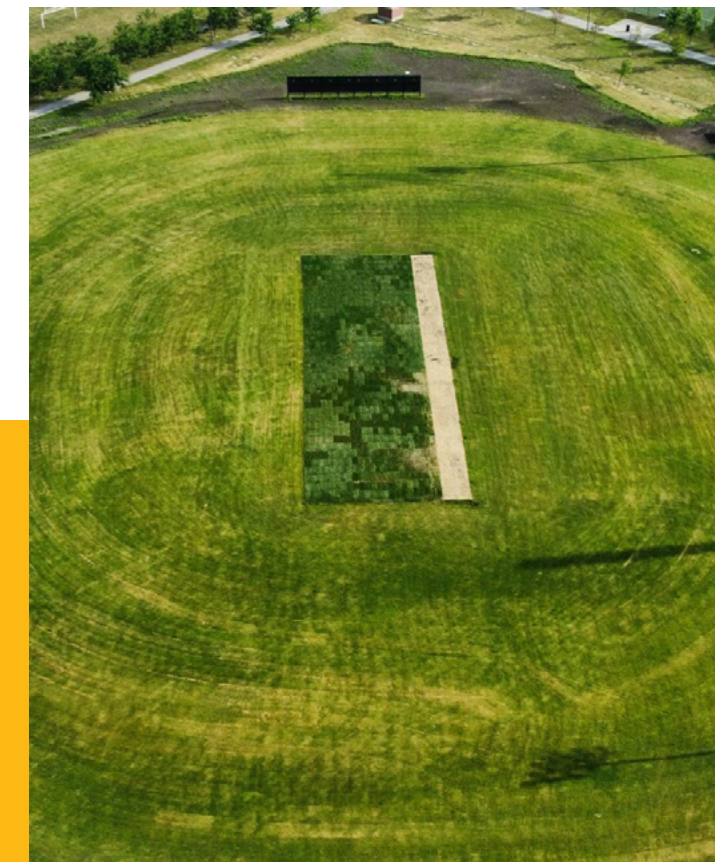
New rinks at Amore Italian Park, Major William Sharpe Park and Sesquicentennial Park provide accessible winter recreation opportunities and encourage outdoor activity during colder months. \*New rinks also coming in 2026 to Duggan Park (larger rink), Bovaird House and Treleven Park!

**Enhanced facilities for competitive play**

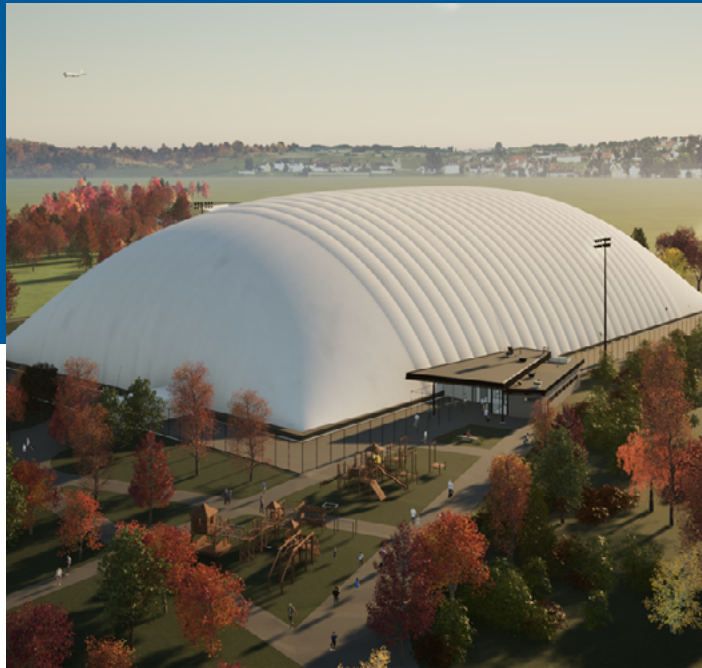
A lit senior cricket pitch designed to accommodate league play and extend playing hours, strengthening Brampton's cricket infrastructure.

## EARNSLIFFE CRICKET DOME

**Supporting Canada's fastest-growing sport, all year long**

Brampton's first dedicated year-round cricket facility will feature a turf field, five-lane batting cage, and seasonal dome to support winter play. Designed to meet the needs of a rapidly growing cricket community, this project strengthens the city's position as a national leader in the sport.

**Square Footage: 137,5000 Dome    2,150 Fieldhouse**

**Target Completion: 2026**



## GORE MEADOWS COMMUNITY PARK

**A major new outdoor hub for a growing community**

One of Brampton's largest park developments, Gore Meadows will feature tennis courts, cricket fields, soccer pitches, and flexible open space. Designed for both organized sport and casual use, it will provide a vibrant destination for recreation and community life.

**Investment: \$49M**

**Target Completion: October 2026**



## CHRIS GIBSON RECREATION CENTRE REVITALIZATION

### Expanding capacity for sport and community activity

This major redevelopment will introduce a new ice pad and gymnasium, significantly increasing programming capacity. The upgraded facility will continue to serve as a central hub for recreation, fitness, and community engagement.

**Investment: \$57.5M**

**Target Completion: Fall 2026**



## CASSIE CAMPBELL MULTI-SPORT TRAINING DOME

### Year-round training for the next generation of athletes

A major new indoor training destination at Cassie Campbell Community Centre, designed to support year-round, high-performance sport. The facility will include a full indoor field hockey pitch, a straight running track with long and triple jump areas, and cricket and baseball batting cages. The facility will also include a fully equipped comfort station with change rooms and washrooms to enhance accessibility and comfort for athletes and community users alike.

**Investment: \$23M**

**Target Completion: Q3 2026**



## SANDALWOOD HEIGHTS ADVENTURE PARK

**An exciting new destination for outdoor play and exploration**

A large-scale adventure park focused on climbing, active play, and unique outdoor experiences, encouraging families and youth to stay active and engaged.

**Investment: \$11.4M**

**Target Completion: October 2026**



## CENTURY GARDENS YOUTH HUB

**A one-stop destination for youth services and connection**

With construction well underway, the new 12,500 sq. ft. youth-focused facility with e-sports, creative spaces, and community services, complemented by outdoor amenities that support engagement and social connection.

**Investment: \$19.5M**

**Target Completion: October 2026**

## NEW VICTORIA PARK ARENA

### A future home for sport, history, and community

- A fully accessible dry-floor hockey rink designed to accommodate multiple sports, including box lacrosse and indoor field hockey
- Change rooms with showers, plus coach and referee rooms
- Multipurpose and universal washroom facilities
- Mezzanine seating for 500 patrons
- Site improvements, landscaping, and the Brampton Sports Hall of Fame

**Investment: \$43.3M**

**Target Completion: Q3 2027**



## NEW HOWDEN RECREATION CENTRE

### Bringing recreation, learning and community together

Construction of a new Howden Recreation Centre is anticipated after the demolition of the existing structure has been completed. The new facility will include a multipurpose gymnasium with a FIBA-sized court, several multipurpose rooms, outdoor courts and play areas. In addition to recreation facilities, the revitalized centre will include a new Brampton Library branch providing residents with access to educational resources, programs, and community spaces.

#### Project highlights:

- Estimated building size: 45,000 sq. ft
- LEED Gold and Net Zero Ready status
- Full site landscaping, including parking and outdoor amenities

#### Indoor facilities include:

- Multi-sport gymnasium
- Change rooms
- Multipurpose rooms for meetings and events

#### Outdoor facilities include:

- Multisport courts
- Leased space for a daycare centre
- Outdoor play areas
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#### Howden Library Branch featuring:

- Educational resources
- Programs
- Community spaces

**Investment: \$80M**

**Target Completion: Q4 2028**
