

**Notice of Intention to Amend User Fee By-law 380-2003  
Brampton Transit / PRESTO Fare System**

The PRESTO farecard is an electronic, contactless farecard system that allows transit riders to travel seamlessly throughout the Greater Toronto and Hamilton area. Now that PRESTO has been fully operational since May 30, 2011, the City of Brampton will begin to eliminate the use of paper fare media, eg. tickets and paper passes.

At its meeting on November 7, 2012 at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers, at the address noted below, Committee of Council will consider amendments to the User Fee By-law 380-2003 to reflect the 2013 Brampton Transit fares and related charges including PRESTO fares and fees. These fare changes, effective January 1, 2013, will assist in the transition from the old paper tickets and passes to a paperless system, whereby all fare payments are made using either PRESTO or cash.

Paper tickets will no longer be available for sale as of January 1, 2013 but they will continue to be accepted as fare payment throughout 2013. Paper passes will remain in circulation until the spring of 2013.

Anyone interested in speaking to this matter or making written submissions should contact the City Clerk's Office no later than 4:30 p.m. on November 6, 2012. In the event that Committee chooses to defer consideration of this matter, no further public notice will be given.
