

Proposed Amendment to User Fee By-law – Fire and Emergency Services Fire Response to Motor Vehicle Collisions

On Wednesday, March 1, 2016 at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers, at the address below, the Committee of Council will consider an amendment to User Fee By-law 380-2003, as amended, with regard to:

- User fees related to motor vehicle collisions and motor vehicle fire responses

The proposal is to amend Schedule F of the City's User Fee By-law in order to align the City rate with Ministry of Transportation revised response rates.

A rate increase of 2.1% has recently been approved by the Ministry of Transportation, based on the Consumer Price Index.

Responses to motor vehicle collisions or fires that occur on Highway 410 are invoiced to the Ministry of Transportation, and responses to motor vehicle collisions or fires that occur on Highway 407 are invoiced to the 407/ETR. When Brampton Fire and Emergency Services responds to motor vehicle collisions or fires on any City street and the vehicle owner is not a resident of Brampton, the owner is charged the same applicable user fee.

The Ministry of Transportation rate per fire truck has increased from \$450.00 per hour to \$459.45 per hour. The half-hour rate has increased from \$225.00 per hour to \$229.76 per hour per truck. The City proposal is that all motor vehicle response rates be amended to align with the revised Ministry of Transportation rates.

The new rates would be effective April 1, 2017.
