

Applications Requested for Citizen Appointments: Brampton Community Safety Advisory Committee Members or Alternate Members for Various Other City Committees

The City of Brampton is seeking applications from citizens interested in being appointed to:

- the new Brampton Community Safety Advisory Committee, and
- as members or alternate members to various other citizen-based City committees

Appointments will be for the remainder of this term of Council, ending November 30, 2018, or until successors are appointed.

Brampton Community Safety Advisory Committee

This newly-formed committee will serve as a resource, information gathering and advisory body to City Council on matters pertaining to community safety and crime prevention in the City of Brampton. It will be responsible for encouraging and promoting activities and education programs for Brampton residents of all ages on injury prevention, pedestrian safety, traffic safety, bicycle safety, water safety and fire prevention. It will promote resident engagement and participation in community safety and crime prevention, such as bully prevention, seniors' safety, neighbourhood watch, and vandalism. The committee will include a minimum of four citizen representatives, one from each of the four quadrants of the City:

- Northeast of Highway 410 and Queen Street East
- Southeast of Highway 410 and Queen Street East
- Southwest of Highway 410 and Queen Street East
- Northwest of Highway 410 and Queen Street East

The advisory committee may form sub-committees and working groups as necessary to address specific issues.

Various Other Citizen-based Advisory Committees:

The City is always looking for citizens to serve on various Council committees as members or alternate members, when vacancies occur. A list of various committees established by Council is available on the City website at www.brampton.ca.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be qualified electors in the City of Brampton. Applicants for the Brampton Community Safety Advisory Committee should also demonstrate expertise and interest in community safety and crime prevention.
