

Proposed Amendments to User Fee By-law 380-2003 Various User Fee Charges

On Wednesday, November 22, 2017 at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers, at the address below, City Council will consider amendments to User Fee By-law 380-2003, as amended, with regard to various proposed 2018 user fee charges including:

- Community Services user fee charges, including recreation fees, facility operation and maintenance fees and animal services fees

- Fire and Emergency Services user fee charges, including fees for fire response services on provincial highways

- Cemetery user fee charges
