



**Proposed User Fees By-law Amendment  
Roll-back of Certain User Fees and Charges and  
Deferral of 2020 Brampton Transit Fare Increases**

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its Regular Meeting on Wednesday, June 10, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., City Council will consider, among other items:

- 1) a by-law to amend User Fee By-law 380-2003, as amended, specifically with regard to:
  - a. Roll-back of certain user fees for various City fees and charges affecting Community Services, Corporate Support Services, Brampton Fire & Emergency Services, Legislative Services, and Public Works & Engineering, and
  - b. Deferral of 2020 Brampton Transit fare increases.

In consideration of the current COVID-19 public health orders restricting public gatherings and requirements for physical distancing between persons, in-person attendance at this Regular Council meeting will be limited to Members of Council and essential City staff only.
