Conveyance of Easement Rights to Alectra Utilities Corporation over a portion of City owned Reserve located at 225 Malta Avenue

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and convey easement rights from a portion of the following municipal property to Alectra Utilities Corporation:

LANDS AFFECTED

Part of Block 7 (0.3m Reserve), Plan 43M-2062 designated, designated as Part 1 on 43R-39979 in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel, being part of PIN 14079-0662 (LT) having a municipal address of 225 Malta Avenue.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Permanent non-exclusive easement rights are to be conveyed to Alectra Utilities Corporation, from a portion of City owned land, for the purpose of Alectra Utilities Corporation to construct, repair, replace, extend, operate and maintain encased duct banks and cables and equipment to the transformer in order to provide hydro to 225 Malta Avenue to permit the construction and completion of the approved development.

When the subject property is to be conveyed to a Utility

For this declaration, authority is delegated to the City Solicitor and Commissioner of Community Services.
