



To Enact a By-law to Impose Special Charges for Local Improvement Work under Ontario Regulation 586/06 of the Municipal Act, 2001 Construction of "Noise Attenuation Barriers" (Noise Walls) on City Property affecting The Villages of Rosedale

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its meeting on Wednesday, February 1, 2023, at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall (with the option of electronic participation), Committee of Council will consider a staff report and proposed by-law to impose special charges for local improvement work, in the form of a noise wall, erected on City property and benefitting the property owners of The Villages of Rosedale.

The specific nature of the local improvement work includes:

• Retrofitting a Noise Wall at The Villages of Rosedale, on the north side of Sandalwood Parkway from Dixie Road to Via Rosedale and west side of Dixie Road from Sandalwood Parkway to approximately 77 m northerly thereof along Dixie Road.
