

Announcing a New Major Bus Transit Facility

The City of Brampton is planning to issue a Request for Prequalification (RFPQ) for a new major transit facility project by early spring 2020. The RFPQ will be seeking submissions from parties interested in leading a multi-disciplinary team to provide design and construction services through a design build construction delivery model.

The City of Brampton is one of the fastest growing cities in Canada over the last couple of decades and is currently Canada's ninth largest city.

As a result Brampton Transit is one of the fastest growing transit systems in Canada. Since 2009, ridership of Brampton Transit has grown by 160%, and over the past five years, ridership has grown by 56 percent, while the population grew by 11 percent.

To address this growth, Transit requires a new facility to be constructed to meet the rapidly growing demands for parking, operating and maintaining the bus fleet. The facility will also be required to take into consideration: the future needs for an electric powered fleet; the ability to expand the facility in the future; and the project is environmentally sustainable in keeping with Council priorities.

The City has acquired land in the northeast quadrant of Brampton to construct this new facility which is projected to be about 55,750 sq. m (600,000 sq. / ft.). This new facility will include an indoor garage to park 250 to 450 buses; a service and maintenance garage; and administrative support spaces.
