

### **Notice of Proposed Procedure By-law Amendment Electronic Meetings of Council, Committees and Boards, and Proxy Voting**

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at its meeting on Wednesday, August 5, 2020, City Council will consider a by-law to amend various sections of Procedure By-law 160-2004, to potentially:

- allow members of a council, local board or committee of either of them to participate electronically in meetings – without the need for in-person attendance or quorum, regardless of the existence of an emergency declaration, and
- allow proxy voting for members of council.
