

Surplus Declaration and Disposal of Open Space Land

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

The lands are located at 40 Loafer's Lake Lane (Loafer's Lake Park), near the northwest corner of Sandalwood Parkway East and Conestoga Drive and are approximately 0.038 acres in size. A site location and key map is included below for reference. The property PINs are PIN14239-0792(LT) and PIN14239-0715(LT).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The subject property comprises a portion of Loafer's Lake Park and a portion of a one (1) foot reserve, located in the extreme southeast corner of the property, is currently vacant and is not required for municipal purposes.

The Property is currently zoned Open Space, designated as Open Space in the Official Plan and is located in the Snelgrove-Heart Lake Secondary Plan.

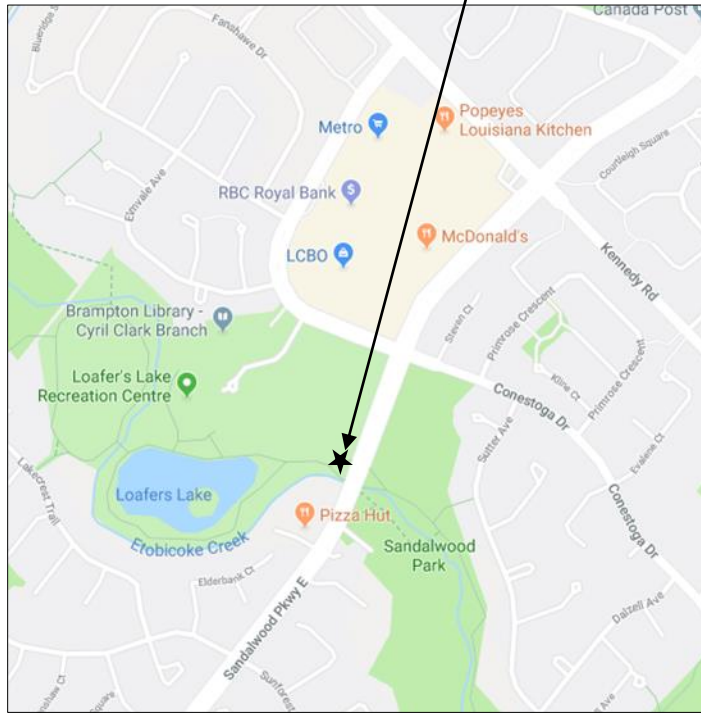
