

Surplus Declaration and Disposal of Easement Interest over portion of City owned Land

LANDS AFFECTED

The lands are located at the east side of Highway 410 on the north side of Countryside Drive and the easement interest to be declared surplus is approximately 0.13 acres in size. A site location and key map is included below for reference. The property PIN is PIN 14225-0142(LT).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The subject property comprises a portion of City owned open space lands, is currently vacant and is not required for municipal purposes.

The Property is currently zoned Flood Plain, designated as Open Space in the Official Plan and is located in the Countryside Villages Secondary Plan Area.
