

Surplus Declaration and Disposal of Open Space Land

PURSUANT to By-law 160-2004, take notice that The Corporation of the City of Brampton intends to declare surplus and dispose the following municipal property:

LANDS AFFECTED

The lands are located adjacent to the Summer Valley Parkette being Part of Block 203 on Plan 43M-1276, save and except an approximately 10 metre strip from the top of the bank of the adjacent Etobicoke Creek, being near the northeast corner of Mayfield Road and Summer Valley Drive and is approximately 0.250 acres in size. A site location and key map is included below for reference. The property PIN is 14235-1048(LT).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The subject property runs along the southerly boundary of Summer Valley Parkette. The property was conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Brampton as part of Subdivision 43M-1276. The property is vacant and is deemed to no longer be required for municipal purposes.

The Property is currently zoned Open Space, designated as Residential in the Official Plan and is designated Recreational Open Space in the Snelgrove-Heart Lake Secondary Plan.

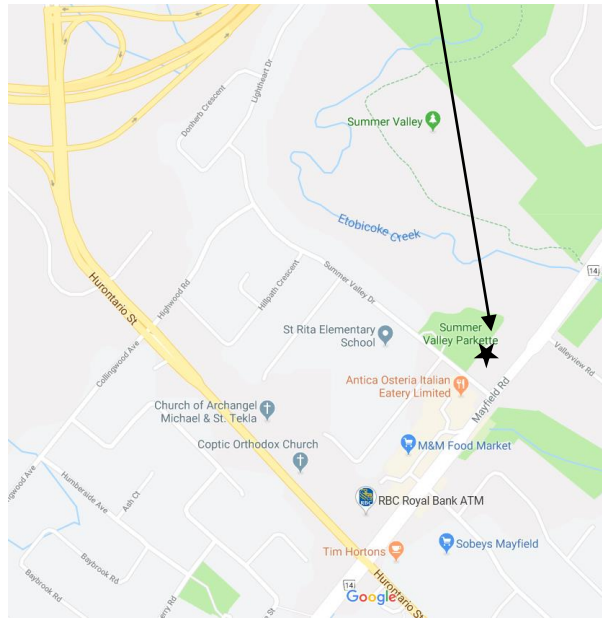
