Notice of Intention to Amend Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014 Various Matters Related to Schedule 2 – Limousines and Schedule 4 – Taxis

The City of Brampton intends to amend Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014 to amend the following aspects of the by-law:

Schedule 2 - Limousines	Current By-law Requirement	Proposed By-law Requirement
Vehicle Requirements	 No age limit for vehicles. 	9 Model Year vehicle age limit.
App Use	 No requirement for approval of App to identify fare pickups. 	 App use for pre-arranged pickups must be approved by Licence Issuer for use.
Schedule 4 - Taxis	Current By-law Requirement	Proposed By-law Requirement
Vehicle Requirements	 Accessible taxis permitted to remain in service for 9 Model Years. Request for extension of Model Year starts after 5 years. Taxicabs permitted to remain in service for 8 Model Years. Request for extension of Model Year starts after 5 years. 	 Accessible taxis permitted to remain in service for 10 Model Years. Request for extension of Model Year starts after 6 years. Taxicabs permitted to remain in service for 9 Model Years. Request for extension of Model Year starts after 6 years.
Fares	No fee for large items.	 Fee may be charged upon agreement between passenger and driver for vans.
Taxi Broker	 Corporation must have a licensed taxi driver holding 51% of voting shares. 	 No requirement for the Corporation having a licensed driver holding 51% of voting shares.
Accessible Vehicle Training	No requirement.	 Accessible taxicab drivers required to submit proof of successful completion of a training program for the transportation of disabled persons and have an endorsement placed on their licence.
