

Purpose and Effect

The City is proposing an amending by-law to correct clerical errors to the numbering of eight (8) previously adopted Official Plan Amendments. The proposed changes are administrative in nature and do not alter the intent, scope or implementation of the original Official Plan Amendments enacted under their respective by-laws.

The current and proposed OPA numbering is outlined below.

As part of this administrative exercise, the City is also correcting duplicated Special Policy Area (SPA) numbers and minor grammatical or typographical errors within the 2006 Official Plan and several Secondary Plans. In addition to the changes outlined in the table, there are subsequent policy renumbering required that are minor in nature to clean up the policy documents. Minor policy renumbering is required for all documents in the table below (not outlined in detail), as well as to the Fletchers Meadow Secondary Plan, Countryside Villages Secondary Plan, and Mount Pleasant Secondary Plan:

Important Information about making a submission

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Brampton with respect to a proposed official plan amendment before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted:

- (a) The person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Brampton to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal; and,
- (b) The person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
