Important Information about making a submission

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Brampton with respect to a proposed plan of subdivision, proposed official plan amendment or proposed zoning by-law amendment before the City gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, or before a zoning by-law is passed, or before a proposed official plan amendment is adopted:

(a) The person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Brampton to the Ontario Municipal Board; and,

(b) The person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
