

**Notice of Passing of  
By-law 218-2019 to Establish Administrative Penalties and  
By-law 219-2019 to Amend and Designate By-laws subject to  
Administrative Penalties (Non-Parking)**

Take notice that at its meeting on Wednesday, September 25, 2019 City Council considered By-law 218-2019 to Establish Administrative Penalties and By-law 219-2019 to Amend and Designate By-laws subject to Administrative Penalties (Non-Parking).

By the adoption of these by-laws a number of other by-laws were amended, including: Adult Entertainment By-law 114-2017, Mobile Licensing By-law 67-2014 and Business Licensing By-law 332-2013.

The amendments provided by By-laws 218-2019 and 219-2019 are considered minor in nature, and primarily state that Administrative Penalties apply in regard to contraventions to these by-laws, effective January 1, 2020.

Anyone interested in speaking to this matter will be given an opportunity at the Committee of Council meeting to be held on January 15, 2020, and should contact the City Clerk's Office, by 4:30 p.m. on January 14, 2020. Written submissions may also be provided by this date and time.
