

Notice of the Intention to Amend Business Licensing and Administrative Penalties By-laws

Pursuant to Procedure By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that on Wednesday, June 17, 2026, at 9:30 am in the Council Chambers, City Hall, the Committee of Council will consider amendments to the following by-laws:

Administrative Penalties (Non-Parking) By-law 218-2019

- **Schedule A, Section 3 – Business Licensing By-law**
 - to increase penalty amounts and implement a graduated administrative penalty structure for failure to comply with an order.

Short-Term Rental By-law 165-2021

- **Part XV – Insurance, Section 61**
 - To replace the requirement for Commercial General Liability insurance with a requirement for General Liability insurance while maintaining the minimum coverage limit of \$2 million; and
 - To increase the required notice period to fifteen (15) days to align with standard insurance notification periods and industry practices.

Residential Rental Licensing By-law 216-2023

- **Part XI - Insurance, Section 50**
 - To increase the required notice period from ten (10) days to fifteen (15) days to align with standard insurance notification periods
