

**Notice of the Intention to Amend: Mobile Licensing Bylaw 101-2025**

Pursuant to Procedure By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that the City of Brampton intends to consider amendments to Mobile Licensing By-law 101-2025.

On Wednesday, September 10, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Council will consider a draft by-law to amend Mobile Licensing By-law 101-2025 and the corresponding recommendation provided by Committee of Council from its meeting held on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, specifically:

WHEREAS By-law 101-2025, Mobile Licensing By-law, was enacted on May 28, 2025;

AND WHEREAS Council is now considering providing an additional grace period as it relates to Level 2 criminal record checks, section as listed.

By-law 101-2025, Mobile Licensing By-law, is amended by adding the following section 54.1 immediately following section 54:

54.1 Notwithstanding sections 11 and 52 of By-law 101-2025, the driver or operator of a Refreshment Vehicle, Tent or Vendor at a Special Event do not require a Level 2 Criminal Record Check.

Section 54.1 of By-law 101-2025 and this Amending By-law will expire at midnight on December 31, 2025.
