

### **Proposed Amendment to Procedure By-law 160-2004 regarding Non-Emergency Electronic Meetings of Council and Committees**

### **Proposed Amendment to Tariff of Fees By-law 85-96; and**

### **Proposed Amendment to Sign By-law 399-2002 to Restrict Signs Identifying an Elected Official or Candidate**

Pursuant to By-law 160-2004, as amended, take notice that at regular electronic meeting on Wednesday, July 8, 2020, at 1:00 p.m., it is anticipated Brampton City Council will consider, among other items:

- 1) a by-law to amend various sections of Procedure By-law 160-2004, to provide for the use of Electronic Meetings in certain circumstances for some members of Brampton City Council and various Committees of Council at times other than during a declared emergency;
- 2) a by-law to amend to update to current levels the Tariff of Fees By-law 85-96, as amended; and
- 3) a proposed amendment to Sign By-law 399-2002, specifically to Restrict Signs Identifying an Elected Official or Candidate for office.
