UPPER NINE STORMWATER POND RETROFIT- PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

The City of Brampton in partnership with the Toronto an Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) is proceeding with the planning and design of the retrofit of the existing stormwater management facility, the Upper Nine Pond, which is located at 84 Havelock Drive (east of Hurontario Street and north of Highway 407). The project is being completed as a Class Environmental Assessment, Schedule A+.

This project has been recommended as part of the ongoing Sustainable Neighbourhood Retrofit Action Plan (SNAP) project for the County Court neighbourhood and was also listed as part of the City of Brampton Stormwater Retrofit and Enhancement Study. The purpose of this pond retrofit is to update the existing Upper Nine Pond to provide water quality control and provide an additional public space and natural area destination. This work will involve the upgrade of existing stormwater quantity facility (dry pond) to a wet pond which will include water quality control to meet the guidelines as established by the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change.

A Public Open House has been scheduled for interested parties, including local landowners and residents, to review and provide input on the details of this project including a design concept for the pond. The Open House will be held as follows:

Staff from the City of Brampton, TRCA and the consulting firm Aquafor Beech Limited will be available to discuss details and to answer any questions about the project and how it may impact you.

If you are unable to attend the Open House, the information will also be available for viewing after Thursday April 13, 2017 at the Public Works and Engineering Department located at 2 Wellington Street West, Brampton ON L6Y 4R2.
