Phase 4B: Elizabeth Street North and George Street North

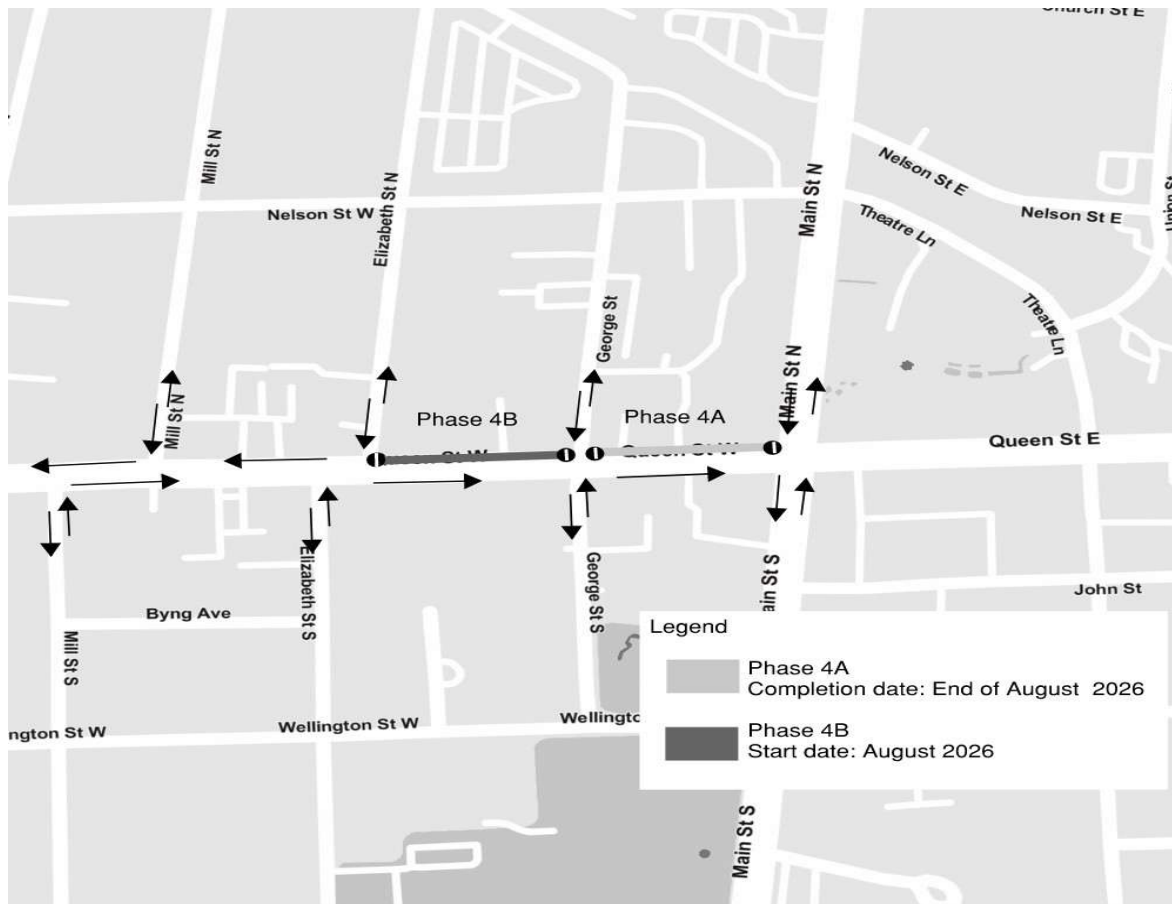
Start Date: August 17, 2026, End Date: October 31, 2026

The City of Brampton is progressing with the Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project. Construction on Phase 4B will begin shortly, while work on Phase 4A (Main Street North to George Street North) continues.

Phase 4B will take place on the north side of Queen Street West, between Elizabeth Street North and George Street North running concurrently with Phase 4A that is scheduled for completion in end of August. During this period, Queen Street will be reduced to a single eastbound lane from Elizabeth Street North to George Street North. Motorists are reminded to follow all posted traffic and construction signage to ensure the safety of all road users, including pedestrians and cyclists.

The contractor will:

- Reduce Queen Street West to one lane of eastbound traffic between Elizabeth Street North and George Street North.
- Maintain pedestrian access to businesses on the north side of Queen Street West.

What to expect during construction

The community may experience dust, noise and traffic delays.

- Local access to driveways will be maintained for all businesses along the affected sections of Queen Street West.
- The City is committed to minimizing impacts wherever possible. Your patience is appreciated.
- Please be advised that on-street parking in this area will be permanently removed.

	Traffic Management: Phase 4B: The Northside of Queen Street West between Elizabeth Street North and George Street North will be reduced to one eastbound lane. • Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	Pedestrians: Sidewalks will remain open for pedestrian use. When sidewalk work is underway, signage will direct pedestrians to a safe crossing.
	Loading Zone: Loading zone on Queen Street West will be permanently removed. Alternate locations available: • George Street North • Elizabeth Street North
	Important information for business owners: Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage. If you have any concerns about the removal of private items, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday.
