The City of Brampton is advancing work on the Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project. Construction work will commence on Phase 4A while the work on phase 3C (Elizabeth St S to Mill St S) continues.

Phase 4A construction zone begins on the north side of Queen Street West between Main Street North and George Street North. Construction on Phase 3C and 4A will be concurrent during the months of April and May. Queen Street will be reduced to one lane of eastbound traffic from George Street North to Main Street North. Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians and cyclists.

Work Details

The contractor will:

- Reduce Queen Street West to one lane of eastbound traffic between Main Street North and George Street North for Phase 4A.
- Reduce Queen Street West to one lane of westbound traffic between Elizabeth Street South and Mill Street South.
- Maintain pedestrian access to businesses on Queen Street West.

What to expect during construction

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- Local access to driveways will be maintained for businesses along the closed sections of Queen Street West.
- **The City is committed to minimizing impacts wherever possible.** Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <p>Phase 4A: Queen Street West between Main Street North and George Street North will be reduced to one eastbound lane.</p> <p>Phase 3C: Queen Street West between Mill Street South and Elizabeth Street South will be reduced to one westbound lane</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At all times access to emergency vehicles will be maintained.
	<p>Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.</p>
	<p>Important information for business owners:</p> <p>Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>If you have any concerns about the removal of private items, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
