
Full Closure: Main Street & Chapel Street/Theatre Lane

Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project

The City of Brampton is continuing work on the Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project. The surface work on the south side of Queen Street East between Main Street and Chapel Street will be completed shortly.

To remove the existing work zone, Queen Street East between Main Street and Chapel Street/Theatre Lane will be **fully closed** from **10:00 p.m. on Monday July 28** to **5:00 a.m. on Tuesday July 29**. Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians and cyclists.

- Close Queen Street from Main Street to Chapel Street/Theatre Lane to eastbound and westbound road traffic.

	<p>Pedestrians: Sidewalks will be kept open for pedestrian use. When work is taking place on the sidewalk, signage will be placed to provide information about which side of the road to use.</p>
