## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

### Queen Street West (south side)

#### Phase 3A: George Street & Main Street

#### Phase 3B: Elizabeth Street South & George Street

Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project

Start Date: July, 2025 End Date: October, 2025

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Brampton is continuing work on the Downtown Brampton Streetscape Project. The surface work on the south side of Queen Street East between Main Street and Chapel Street will be completed shortly. The construction zone will shift to the corresponding west side of George Street scheduled late July 2025, while the current phase 3A work from George Street to Main Street continues.

The construction activity will be in two phases with each phase lasting for roughly three months. Phase 3A construction zone remains on the south side of Queen Street West between George Street and Main Street effective May 2025 until August 2025. Phase 3B construction zone begins on the south side of Queen Street West between Elizabeth Street South and George Street effective July 2025. Phase 3A and 3B construction zones are to be active concurrently until completion of Phase 3A. Queen Street will be reduced to one lane of westbound traffic from Main Street to Mill Street North. Motorists are reminded to abide by traffic/construction signs posted in local areas to ensure the safe travel of all local road users, pedestrians and cyclists.

## WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Reduce Queen Street West to one lane of westbound traffic between Mill Street North and Main Street for Phase 3A and 3B.
- Maintain pedestrian access to businesses on the south side of Queen Street.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise and traffic delays.
- Local access to driveways will be maintained for businesses along the closed sections of Queen Street West.
- **The City is committed to minimizing impacts wherever possible.** Your patience is appreciated.
